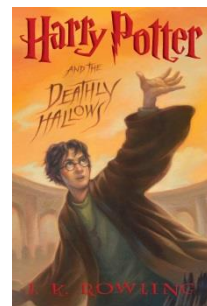

Joanne Kathleen Rowling (born 31 July 1965 in Yate, South Gloucestershire) is a British author who created Harry Potter. She invented Harry Potter in 1990 on a train ride. In 1997 the first book was published and after her big success she sold the book rights to Carlsen Verlag and film rights to Time Warner. The last book of the Harry Potter series was published in 2007 and now she's one of the richest women in Great Britain.
